November on the A453 urban section

Here's an update from us to make you aware of some of the upcoming works.
(These works are subject to change due to weather conditions.)

Crusader Roundabout

Works at Crusader roundabout will be ongoing until the end of November 2014.

- Night time works will be taking place during this month to surface the footpaths and the build-ups to the roundabout.
- Final surfacing works on the roundabout due to finish by the end of this month!



Nottingham Trent Uni



- Traffic is planned to be switched onto the newly completed side of the road on the night of the 14th November, after which works will commence to improve the 'old' road.

Green Lane Junction

Works at Green Lane Junction are planned for completion February 2015. Works are currently ongoing through November and December to various locations within the junction.



Farnborough Road Junction

- Road surfacing during the night will be ongoing in early November in order to achieve a Traffic Switch through the junction on 14th November.
- Traffic alignment will change after the 14th November switch, the new alignment is the first stage of the permanent design.
- Anticipated completion date is March 2015.
