Temporary closure on Station Street for preparatory works

In preparation for the improvement scheme being undertaken on Station Street, we are pleased to let you know that preparatory works are now due to start.

These improvements are part of a programme of works to support economic growth in the area. The programme is funded by Nottingham City Council, Regional Growth Fund City Deal and the European Regional Development Fund.

The Station Street Environmental Improvement Scheme is planned to feature new paving, new road surfaces and new traffic management measures to enhance the appearance of the area.

The scheme will be built in phases and is expected to be completed by the end of 2016.

The first phase of the improvements is due to start on **Monday 7th September 2015** to carry out preparatory works including setting up the works site, repairing a collapsed sewer, ground investigations, installing new drainage and preparing the surfaces to lay new paving.

The road will be closed between Tesco express and the Hopkinson Vintage, Antiques and Arts Centre.

Access to off-street parking will be maintained – the route will be the existing arrangement from Trent Street or along Station Street from London Road.

A designated loading area will be created on Station Street at its junction with Carrington Street to allow deliveries to businesses. Access to this area will be via Canal Street and Carrington Street. Vehicles will need to exit back onto Carrington Street.

Pedestrian access will be maintained on the north side of Station Street during this phase of the works. The head of the Taxi Rank will be relocated opposite Loxley House on Station Street at the bottom of the Station's footbridge access.

We will be providing more details about the next phase of the improvements in the coming weeks.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience that these works may cause you, and would like to assure you that we will do all that we can to keep disruption to a minimum.
